

GDPR and Confidentiality Policy Cayman Pharma, Czech Republic

Cayman Pharma s.r.o. undertakes to ensure that information is properly secured against breaches of confidentiality, integrity, availability, and compliance, as described in the internal documentation related to GDPR principles.

Cayman Pharma s.r.o. undertakes to make reasonable efforts to inform in advance any third party whose confidential information may be disclosed at the request of a legal authority.

Third-Party Information

Cayman Pharma s.r.o. undertakes to provide its customers with services involving confidential information. No information provided to our company will be shared with any other organization or individual without the explicit consent of the source of the information. Confidential information may be shared with directors, managers, employees, lawyers, accountants, and financial advisors of Cayman Pharma s.r.o. only if they need to know such information for the performance of their duties.

Confidentiality non-Disclosure Agreement

Formal protection of transmitted and received data in dealings with third parties is ensured through a so-called Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA). By signing this document, each party undertakes to maintain the confidentiality of the subject of the agreement and all its parts contained therein.

Confidentiality Breach

If an employee believes that a breach of confidentiality has occurred, may have occurred, or is about to occur, the following steps are taken:

- The employee should immediately report the matter to their supervisor
- The supervisor is responsible for deciding whether a breach of confidentiality has occurred or may have occurred in the given case and for taking appropriate measures
